Trump mocks DeSantis at Pennsylvania rally: 'Ron DeSanctimonious'

Trump is widely expected to announce his 2024 candidacy this month

Former [President Donald Trump](#) took a swipe at Florida Republican Gov. Ron DeSantis at a rally on Saturday night referring to him as "Ron DeSanctimonious" in what could be a sign of growing tension between the two potential presidential candidates.

"We're winning big in the Republican Party for the nomination like nobody's ever seen before," Trump told a crowd in [Latrobe, Pennsylvania](#), on Saturday night before going down the list of other Republicans who could potentially challenge him in 2024.

"There it is, Trump at 71%, Ron DeSanctimonious at 10%," Trump told the crowd while reading approval numbers of various Republicans.

"Mike Pence at 7, oh, Mike is doing better than I thought," Trump continued. "Liz Cheney there's no way she's at 4%. There's no way. There's no way. But we're at 71 to 10 to 7 to 4."

The jab from Trump comes as the two are widely considered the two top Republican contenders to clinch the Republican presidential nomination and reports have circulated about possible growing tension between the two camps.

DeSantis [dismissed rumors](#) of a rift between him and Trump earlier this year saying that Trump is a "friend of mine."

"He wants to see Republicans doing well," DeSantis told Fox News in February. "And I think when media is trying to act like he's upset at me for doing well, I think that's total bunk. I think they're just making it up."

Over the last few months, Trump [routinely outperforms DeSantis](#) in polls of Republican voters ahead of 2024, but the governor remains Trump's most prominent potential rival.

A presidential straw poll at the Turning Point USA Student Action Summit found that 78.7% of attendees [favored Trump](#) to be the Republican nominee in 2024. Another straw poll at the Conservative Political Action Conference in August found that Trump had 69% support from attendees to run in 2024. DeSantis came in with just 24% support.

Trump publicly voiced displeasure with DeSantis last month after the Florida Republican endorsed Colorado Republican Senate candidate Joe O'Dea despite O'Dea's vocal criticism of Trump.

"A BIG MISTAKE!" Trump posted on Truth Social in response to the move.

Trump will be attending a rally in Florida to support Florida Republican Marco Rubio on Sunday in Miami at an event that [Fox News reported](#) did not include an invitation for DeSantis, despite his immense popularity with Republicans in the state.

Trump has not yet said whether he plans to run for president, but many political experts believe he will make the announcement shortly after Tuesday's midterm elections.

DeSantis [refused to say](#) during a debate last month whether he will run in 2024 fueling speculation that he is considering throwing his hat in the ring.

Representatives for DeSantis and Trump did not immediately respond to a request for comment from Fox News Digital.

Why Are So Many Young People Dying Suddenly?

If the push notifications on my computer are any indication, an alarming trend is unfolding before our eyes: ***young, seemingly healthy individuals are dropping like flies, dying suddenly.***

It wasn't always like this. Sure, the death notifications of high-profile figures would come occasionally, but they were usually for those in their 80s or 90s who had simply come to the end of a long life, or for young individuals who had committed suicide. Now it's different.

The other day, it was Baltimore Ravens linebacker Jaylon Ferguson. He was 26 and had played three seasons of professional football. No cause of death was given, [CNN reported](#).

Then there was 25-year-old Caleb Swanigan. The former NBA player had been the 2017 Big Ten Player of the Year at Purdue University. The coroner report concluded that Swanigan died of natural causes, [CBS reported](#).

A few days before Swanigan's death was revealed, Danielle Hampson, the fiancée of *X Factor* star Tom Mann, died *on their wedding day*. She "did not suffer from any known health problems and her cause of death is unknown," [the Daily Mail reported](#). She was only 34.

The deaths of these three individuals happened (or were reported on) in only the last few days. And these are just high-profile instances. If this many celebrities are unexpectedly dropping dead, how many average, non-celebrity deaths are occurring with individuals in their prime years and health?

Potentially quite a few. "[Healthy young people are dying suddenly and unexpectedly from a mysterious syndrome](#)," a *Daily Mail* headline proclaimed in early June. ***The syndrome, known as Sudden Adult Death Syndrome, or SADS, seems to affect the heart, as doctors are encouraging people under 40 to get this primary organ checked.***

Good journalists are supposed to ask questions, yet in the midst of what seems like a catastrophe in the making, I don't see many in the media who are even curious about why we are suddenly seeing so many young people dying. So I'll ask a few questions of my own.

Could these sudden deaths be related to the mass-rollout of the COVID vaccine we've seen in the last year and a half? If so, why are these deaths seemingly on the rise even as COVID vaccinations are dropping (at least in the U.S.)? *Is it possible that the sudden increase in SADS is due to the long-term health effects of the COVID vaccines?*

Questions such as these are taboo and raised only by a handful of journalists, doctors, or scientists who want to know the truth. They often pay for such questions by being canceled, ostracized, or by having their professional license revoked. Yet for those who have eyes to see, not only experience, but science as well, is beginning to reward their tenacity for finding the truth.

Scientific studies are increasingly producing results that support a healthy skepticism regarding the experimental vaccines. For example, a recent study in the journal Andrology confirms that COVID vaccines decrease sperm counts. Meanwhile, a study in Science shows the ineffectiveness of the vaccine against the disease it is supposed to prevent. Furthermore, a new study (still in the preprint phase) shows that the vaccines' numerous adverse effects move the risk benefit of the vaccines into negative territory.

Such studies call into question the boatloads of information we've been fed by public officials and scientific experts regarding the virus, the vaccine, and our response to both. Have we been sorely misled, and will such misleading end in serious harm to ourselves and our loved ones?

It shouldn't surprise us if such is the case, for as C. S. Lewis explains in *The Abolition of Man*, the power that scientific discovery and exploration brings is soon corrupted and used for control of the masses. "The last men, far from being the heirs of power, will be of all men most subject to the dead hand of the great planners and conditioners and will themselves exercise least power upon the future," Lewis wrote.

Why is this the case?

Man's conquest of Nature, if the dreams of some scientific planners are realized, means the rule of a few hundreds of men over billions upon billions of men. There neither is nor can be any simple increase of power on Man's side. Each new power won by man is a power over man as well. Each advance leaves him weaker as well as stronger. In every victory, besides being the general who triumphs, he is also the prisoner who follows the triumphal car.

Perhaps the ever-growing number of sudden and early deaths will jolt us awake to the fact that we, too, may be the prisoners following blindly behind the cars of "experts" who love to use today's scientific advances to promote tomorrow's control of society.

The PayPal Fiasco Was No Accident

[PayPal](#) on Oct. 8 sent out an update to its terms of use, or acceptable use policy (AUP), that included a shocking addition. It reserved the right to confiscate \$2,500 from people's accounts if they spread "[misinformation](#)." It was a clear announcement of what many already suspected: PayPal has enlisted in the information war.

This comes weeks after PayPal blocked several important accounts in the UK, including Toby Young's personal account, the Free Speech Union, and the DailySceptic. These are hugely important venues for the English-speaking world in countering the COVID propaganda narrative. It was no accident that they were targeted.

After global protests and news coverage from alternative sources, PayPal relented and restored their accounts without explanation.

In a similar vein, protests all over the world poured in about PayPal's new policy. Twitter filled up with announcements from people who were canceling their accounts.

By the following day, PayPal reversed itself, claiming that the banning of "misinformation" was just a mistake.

"An AUP notice recently went out in error that included incorrect information," a spokesperson [told](#) The Epoch Times. "PayPal is not fining people for misinformation and this language was never intended to be inserted in our policy."

In other words, PayPal claimed that its policy on misinformation was itself misinformation!

It's very likely that the user protest itself—and a big selloff in PayPal stock—made the crucial difference. Many people cheered, but actually, this is extremely

unsettling. We can't live in a world where our essential rights, privacy, and liberties always hang in the balance and depend on Twitter-based protests in order to have them recognized.

In addition, surely PayPal doesn't expect that anyone on the planet really believes the claim that this was an "error." There's just no way. Everyone knows that something as legally and institutionally critical as the acceptable use policy would have to go through many layers of compliance bureaucracy and attorneys, especially highlighting the changes.

This change was so obviously approved at the highest levels. It was intended to stick, and PayPal had every intention of preparing the way to confiscate funds from people based on their political loyalties and opinions. This is truly how bad it has gotten.

I'm particularly intrigued by the way in which The Washington Post reported on the story:

"PayPal is facing blowback after proposing rules that would have allowed it to fine users \$2,500 for promoting misinformation—which the online payment service has since called an error.

"Over the weekend, several conservative outlets reported that the tech company updated its terms of agreement, under which PayPal can levy fines against users for violations, to include 'the sending, posting, or publication of any messages, content, or materials' that 'promote[s] misinformation.'

"The update immediately sparked uproar online on the right, marking the latest instance that a major online payment service has faced heat over its moderation practices."

Did you catch that? ***The Post is careful to note that the protests were from "conservative" outlets and that it "sparked uproar online on the right."***

This is a way of signaling their readership: It was a good policy and they would have gotten away with it but for the meddling kids on the right. Just to be clear: The Post never uses the terms conservative or right without meaning wrong, marginalized, dangerous, and cancellable.

What they say about the protests seems empirically correct, though not entirely. The former president of PayPal, David Marcus, [wrote](#) on Twitter: “It’s hard for me to openly criticize a company I used to love and gave so much to. But @PayPal’s new AUP goes against everything I believe in. A private company now gets to decide to take your money if you say something they disagree with. Insanity.”

Elon Musk liked the tweet.

Then, Brendan Carr, a commissioner of the Federal Communications Commission, [weighed in](#): “Orwellian. Paypal reserves the right to take your money if you post a message that Paypal decides is ‘misinformation.’ This is why it is so vital that state and federal legislatures pass laws that prohibit discrimination by tech companies and protect [free speech](#).”

We know by now exactly what [Big Tech](#) companies mean by “misinformation.” They mean information that belies regime priorities. It began with COVID and extended to vaccines. Now it includes climate change. Indeed, every bit of opining or evidence that seems to go against the prevailing agenda of the Gates Foundation, the Biden administration, or the World Economic Forum is being systematically deprecated by Big Tech. That applies to Google, Facebook, Twitter, Amazon, and now PayPal.

The war on information freedom is intensifying by the day. This little victory over PayPal is sweet, but everyone knows it’s a temporary concession. They didn’t like the bad public relations messaging. Since the release of the policy, the company has likely experienced a record number of account cancellations. They changed the policy to stop the bleeding.

In that sense, we have seen what works. At the very least, these people have to obey market signals because they have a customer base and must deal with the basic demands of bookkeeping. They not only have to please government interests, but also the public insofar as they still depend on willing users.

Still, the trajectory here is very clear. It’s the most frightening step in the ongoing rise of tyranny in the world today that your very ability to move money or even to earn an income will be officially declared as contingent upon the opinions you express.

It's next-level despotism that hasn't yet happened in any systematic way in the United States. *In China, this has become institutionalized. The past year has shown us many examples of how the Chinese Communist Party uses digital apps to turn on or off people's ability to speak, associate, travel, and move money. Compliance is everything.*

To some extent in Canada, this is already happening, as the government invaded the bank accounts of protesting truckers and those who supported them with donations.

How much does it matter that PayPal reversed course? It isn't entirely clear. They showed their hand and revealed a much deeper and scarier plan that relates to the Biden administration's intention to create a new central bank digital currency. This will be programmable money, one that would allow a ruling elite to cut off your means to live if they so choose.

It's all too tragic. PayPal was set up initially as a means of obtaining financial independence from government-controlled banks. It even hoped to become an independent form of money. All these years later, it has been captured by interests that have the very opposite ambition. In truth, many people out there cheer the prospect.

That's how intense the political war has become in this country. We used to debate. We used to talk. We reveled in the freedom that was guaranteed by a constitutional republic. Today, many interest groups—many of them associated, for now, mainly with the left—no longer want to play that game. They want you deplatformed, canceled, and even left bereft of your ability to earn a living or feed your family.

It's a new age of brutalism, and the technologies that were supposed to prevent it are now being deployed to usher it in and entrench it.

'Demonization of Fossil Fuels' Is Driving Diesel Shortage Crisis, Supplier Says

The Biden administration's attacks on the energy industry is a main driver behind the impending [diesel](#) crisis in the United States, a major supplier has said.

The Democrat's "demonization of fossil fuels" and energy policies that are being marketed as being "green" are behind the nationwide diesel and heating oil shortages, Mike Taylor of Combined Energy Services told [Fox News' Tucker Carlson](#).

The top executive for a U.S. energy supplier in the northeast, said that far-left policies are restricting energy production and preventing it from keeping up with critical consumer needs in the region.

National average diesel prices are 33 percent higher for November deliveries and are expected to go up even more, [reported CNBC](#).

U.S. diesel reserves are at their lowest levels since 1951, while a ban on Russian energy is set to take effect next year, which will only increase competition for fuel supplies worldwide.

The United States is reportedly on the verge of running out of diesel fuel in less than a month, according to the Energy Information Administration (EIA).

The nation's diesel supply has fallen to 25 days over the last two weeks, well below the 35-40 days that offers a comfortable buffer for the fuel markets.

At least seven southeastern states are at "code red" levels as stockpiles of diesel hit rock bottom, Mansfield Energy [told](#) customers on Oct. 25.

The "code red" alerts have been applied in Maryland, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, Alabama, and Tennessee.

Looming Hardship

The American economy is dependent on the supply of diesel fuel. Without it, commercial traffic—especially trucking and non-electric powered railroad lines—will come to a halt.

Almost all consumer items are transported across the country via truck or by train.

If locations run out of diesel, commerce would be paralyzed, leading to a cascade effect on everything ranging from retail to groceries.

Meanwhile, supplies of diesel distillates, such as heating oil and jet fuel, have fallen to their lowest levels in more than 10 years, Taylor said.

He said that New England will freeze this winter because of Democrat-led policies.

“The climate change agenda in the Northeast, Tucker, is really what’s causing this,” he said, citing the “demonization of fossil fuels” by Biden’s White House.

Diesel inventories in New England and New York are down over 50 percent since last year and at their lowest levels since 1990, Andy Lipow, president of Lipow Oil Associates, told CNBC.

Lipow said East Coast refineries are trying to produce as much diesel as possible, but they are dependent on seaborne shipments of crude.

Any serious delay in the weather can cause a terminal to run out of supplies.

East Coast refineries operated at 100 percent capacity in June and July, but now they are running at 102 percent, according to the EIA,

“No more supply is forthcoming from the four East Coast refineries,” Lipow said.

Taylor said most of the northeast’s supplies of diesel, kerosene, home heating oil, and other fuels, comes from refineries in the Philadelphia and New York metro areas.

The Midwest is also seeing supply constraints, raising prices for farmers, reported CNBC.

Democrat Policies, Sanctions On Moscow Blamed For Shortages

Additionally, oil from Russia will soon no longer be able to supplant restrictions imposed on domestic U.S. production, due to the sanctions the Biden administration has imposed on Moscow.

Energy traders are currently diverting oil tankers away from Europe to the United States because the price of diesel is now higher here than in Europe.

The United States may face increasing competition with Europe for diesel, particularly after the sanctions on Russia take effect in February 2023.

Taylor also said that the states pushing detrimental “green” energy policies are the same ones sourcing much of the fuel, being very reliant on it.

He explained that New Jersey and New York are “on the fast track to try to eliminate” the types of energy resources Americans still rely on, which are now facing shortages.

“All of our oil comes out of that region,” Taylor told Carlson.

“It floats up through New York Harbor, and that supplies New England. We’ve already seen curtailments and shortages up on the Hudson River terminals. That was early October,” he explained. His firm’s operation are based in the Catskills of southeastern New York.

“Our suppliers are really saying it’s a fine tightrope ... that if we have a drastically cold winter could be trouble.”

All of New England and the Mid-Atlantic states have signed onto the RGGI cap-and-trade pact, which critics say will quickly lead to double digit increases in home heating costs, in addition to other shortages.

Pennsylvania and Virginia also currently on a moratorium on state-parkland fossil fuel speculation, due to Democrat-led policy. But Republicans in the two states are pledging to pull out of that pact if they win.

Meanwhile, Taylor noted that the resumption of operations at a key refinery in Paulsboro, New Jersey, near Philadelphia is a good sign, as reserves remain at 60 percent of the five-year average.

High Diesel Prices to Hurt Lower Income Families' Heating Bills

Taylor said that \$7 a gallon Kerosene is hurting low-income Americans the most, as many of their homes are often heated by kerosene or propane.

"It's very hard to get [kerosene] right now and it's going to be unaffordable," he warned if the same energy policies continue to rule the day.

Taylor added that the average heating oil price is now at \$6 in the colder northeast—up \$3.50 since Biden took office.

One major issue preventing the northeast from receiving additional diesel is the Jones Act, also known as the Merchant Marine Act of 1920, which prohibits a foreign vessel from transporting all goods between two U.S. ports.

Refiners are pressuring the Biden administration to relax the shipping ban.

The 25-day diesel supply estimate can be misleading, said Patrick De Haan, head of petroleum analysis for GasBuddy.

"That number will move around. It's been as high as 40," he said. "That's not days of supply, it's a calculation based on supply and demand right now."

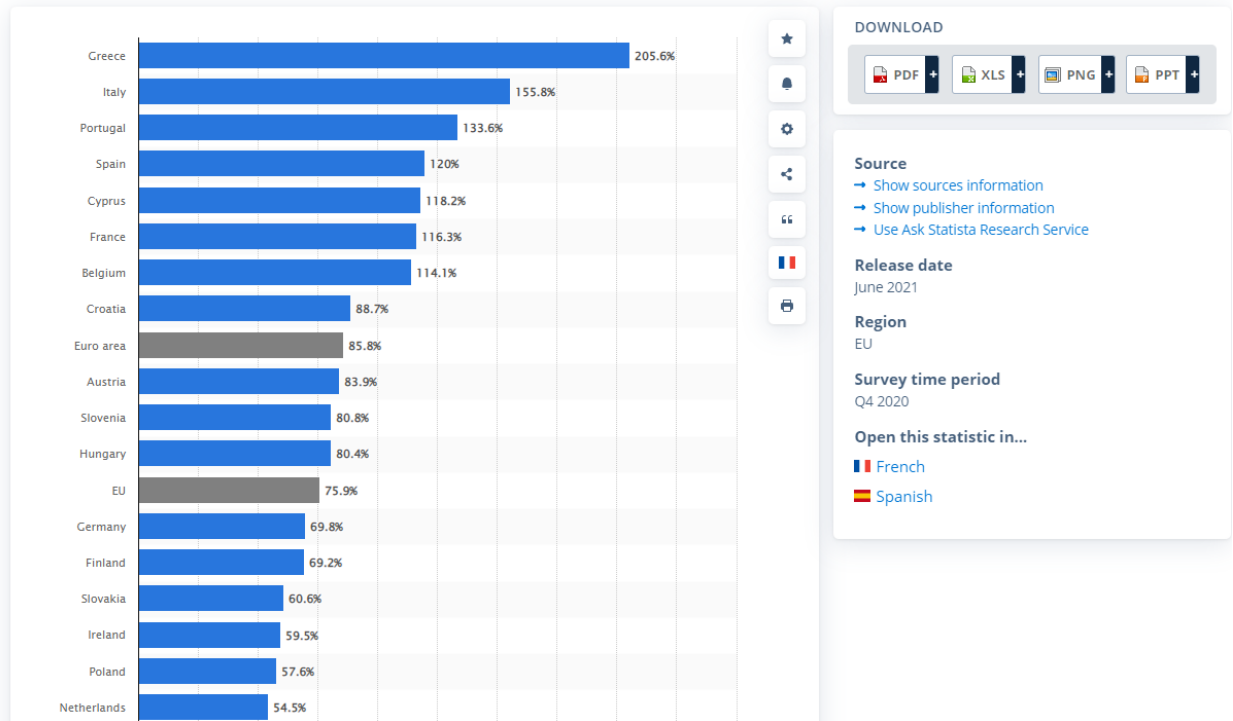
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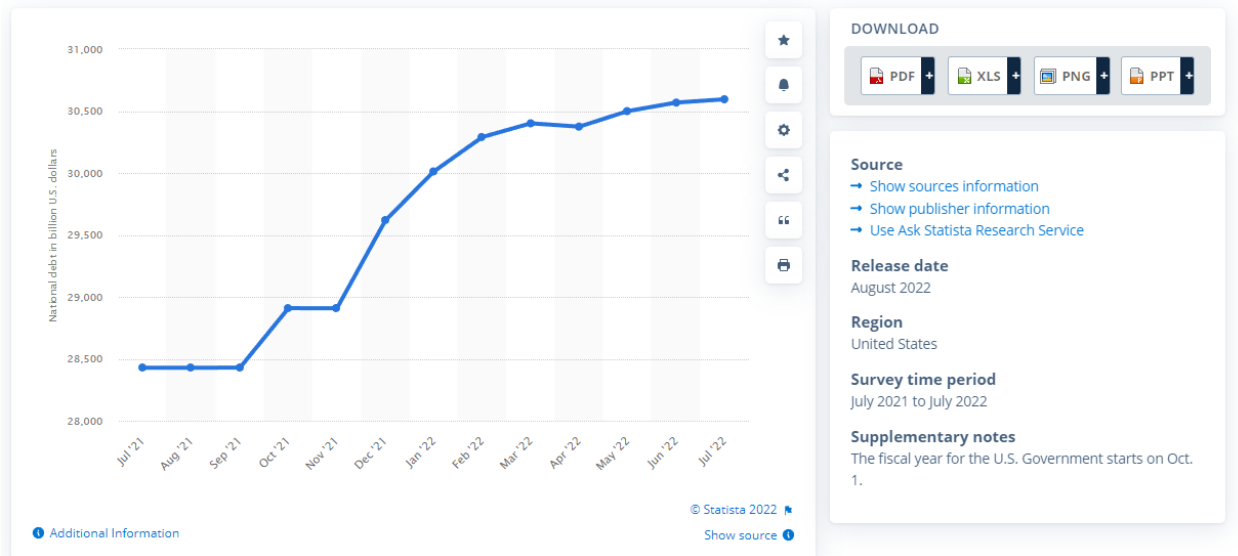

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[Green energy policies in Europe](#) designed to rapidly shift the continent away from fossil fuel dependence have contributed to soaring power prices in the region.

The European benchmark index measuring future electricity prices increased to a record \$993 per megawatt hour (MWh) on Monday, days after prices in France and Germany surged 25%, according to European Energy Exchange data compiled by Bloomberg. By comparison, the average price of electricity in the U.S. hit \$129 per MWh in June, federal data showed.

The energy crisis has forced consumers to cut back on power consumption, industrial production declines and energy rationing across the continent. The European Union Council (EU) scheduled an emergency meeting of EU energy ministers slated for next week in response to the market conditions.

"The skyrocketing electricity prices are now exposing, for different reasons, the limitations of our current electricity market design," European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen remarked during a speech Monday. Food Shortages Have Been Manufactured to Usher in Centralized Public-Private Partnerships for Controlling the Masses

We've been warning about the coming food crisis for some time, but I've never gone into detail about how it will likely all play out. This is what I believe to be the "master plan" being enacted.

There's a line in the iconic television show *Breaking Bad* that applies to what we're seeing today. I'm not going to give context as I'd never want to spoil the show for anyone still interested in seeing it, but the line goes like this, "You're the smartest guy I ever met, and you're too stupid to see he made up his mind 10 minutes ago."

This line rings in my head anytime I talk to otherwise intelligent people who don't realize the food shortages in America that Joe Biden warned about in March are already here. Some will tell me they "may" come in the months or years ahead if we don't turn things around. Others will argue they've been hearing about food shortages in America for decades and it never comes to pass. One compared my "alarmism" about coming food shortages to climate change maniacs claiming we're all going to die in ten years, something they've been saying every ten years for the last five decades.

To be perfectly clear for anyone who isn't familiar with my history, I have panned alarmists for years. I was never a "prepper" until very recently because I didn't see a realistic threat on the horizon. I didn't clear out my bank accounts for Y2K. I didn't build a doomsday bunker after the 2008-09 economic turmoil. I ripped on people who bought two years worth of toilet paper in spring, 2020.

Today, I'm ringing the alarm bells because the threat is real. It's already happening. The foundation for massive, widespread food shortages in America are already in place. It is impossible to know for sure if it can be reversed. Unlike gas prices which are easy to predict and even adjust with the right policies (see my [interview with Congressman Louie Gohmert](#) for an explanation of why this is the case), food prices

are difficult to predict and even harder to adjust because of the decentralized nature of production, distribution, and retailing. This decentralization in America is important to understand because it plays into the machinations of the globalist elites; I'll elaborate on that a little later.

We've talked ad nauseam about the various factors herding us toward food shortages. Bird flu, manufactured or not, is a big one. We've seen recent inexplicable mass die-offs of cattle in recent weeks. The Ukraine-Russia war is just one major factor keeping both grains and all-important fertilizer near critical levels. Of course, we can't forget about the "random" rash of food processing plants being disabled. And as massive as this perfect storm of unfortunate food events is, there are many more factors that are killing food security here and around the globe with 1,000 papercuts.

One of the biggest factors that far too few are discussing is skyrocketing diesel prices. Sure, corporate media is talking about it in the context of gas prices as well as distribution, but few outside of agricultural publications are ringing the alarm bells about the gargantuan impact this is having on farmers. We're not just talking about higher costs for farming businesses that already have slim margins. We're talking about farms large and small being unable to produce crops at all. They would literally have to pay in order to lose money growing America's food. It behooves them to stop producing completely this season as a direct result of diesel prices and other factors making farming cost-prohibitive.

Below is an article by Mac Slavo from [SHTF Plan](#) detailing what's happening with farmers and diesel prices. After Mac's article, I'll go into details about what all this means and what I believe to be the next stage in what is unambiguously a Hegelian Dialectic in action.

Famine: Diesel Prices Hit Farmers Hard, Food Is Going To Get Scarce

Food is going to become a luxury if things do not turn around quickly. Farmers are struggling to make ends meet while producing food as diesel prices continue to climb.

This is an issue that is also being faced by the trucking industry from coast to coast as the average diesel price now stands at \$5.77 per gallon. A year ago, it was only

A Pennsylvania farmer, Kyle Kotzmoyer, said that he has a tractor hooked up to his corn planter, but with no diesel fuel, [because he couldn't afford any](#). The crushing reality is that record diesel fuel prices are pushing farmers like himself to the brink, and this could affect food availability. “We have reached that point where it is very close to being a sinking ship. We are teetering on the edge right now,” Kotzmoyer, who also serves as a legislative affairs specialist for the Pennsylvania Farm Bureau, said in front of state lawmakers.

Kotzmoyer also made it clear that food may not be as readily available because of the fuel price surge. Farmers these days may not be able to put food on the ground or they can't get the food out because farms use diesel-operated machinery. Even if they can get it out of the ground, it'll be much more labor-intensive and cause the prices of food to rise even more.

Craig Moss, a farmer in Hull, Iowa, said: “We had some farm diesel delivered yesterday, and it cost us \$4.85 or \$4.89 a gallon delivered. Two years ago, we bought fuel for just over \$1.”

We are staring down the barrel of a real famine and nothing looks like it's easing up at all, in fact, everything that can go wrong continues to while people struggle to put food on the table. Not only is that a concern in and of itself, but as prices continue to rise, farmers may have to make the tough calls of not growing anything or raising prices to cover their costs. Either way, none of this is looking good.

[Nutrient Survival](#) is the Cadillac of long-term food storage. Between the three of them, I believe my readers will find a good match. Or two. Or three.

Even if you decide to buy from somewhere else, just do it. My intention here is not to sell my sponsors' food. It's to get as many Americans as possible to stop ignoring the food crisis or thinking they'll stock up later. When it hits, it will hit fast. We are seeing creeping food shortages, inflation, and empty shelves now, but there will likely be a triggering event sometime in the future that drives it all over the cliff. Then, it would be too late. Again, I hate fearmongering but I earnestly believe this to be the case. Please don't wait.

Start gardening if you can. Get the basics like rice and beans - hundreds or even thousands of pounds if possible. Get buckets of food. Don't forget the water; if things go south and water stops coming out of the faucet, most Americans would be in a world of hurt. There are many other things we need to do to prepare, but food and water are the most pressing for a majority of Americans. Some need life-preserving medicines, so stock up on those as well.

This could all happen in days or weeks. More likely, it will happen in months or within the next two years. I don't see it extending far beyond that without divine intervention. The powers-that-be are accelerating their timelines. If you're willing to see that this is happening, then please do not make the mistake of thinking you'll get prepared at the last minute. We may already BE in the last minute. Take action now.
